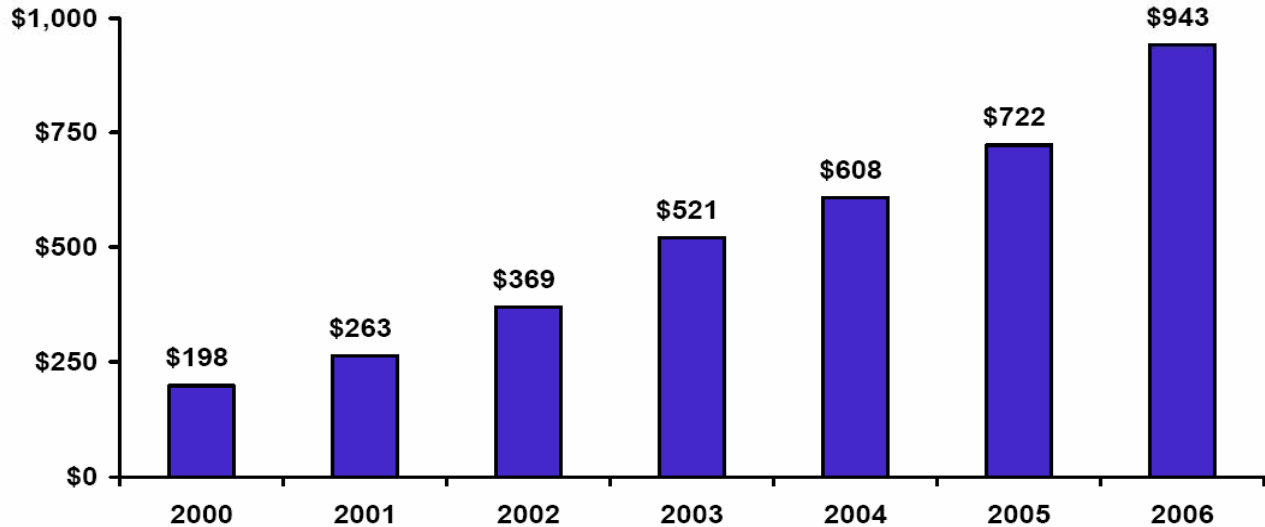




Virginia Exports to China (\$ million)

 Total Exports: 21%

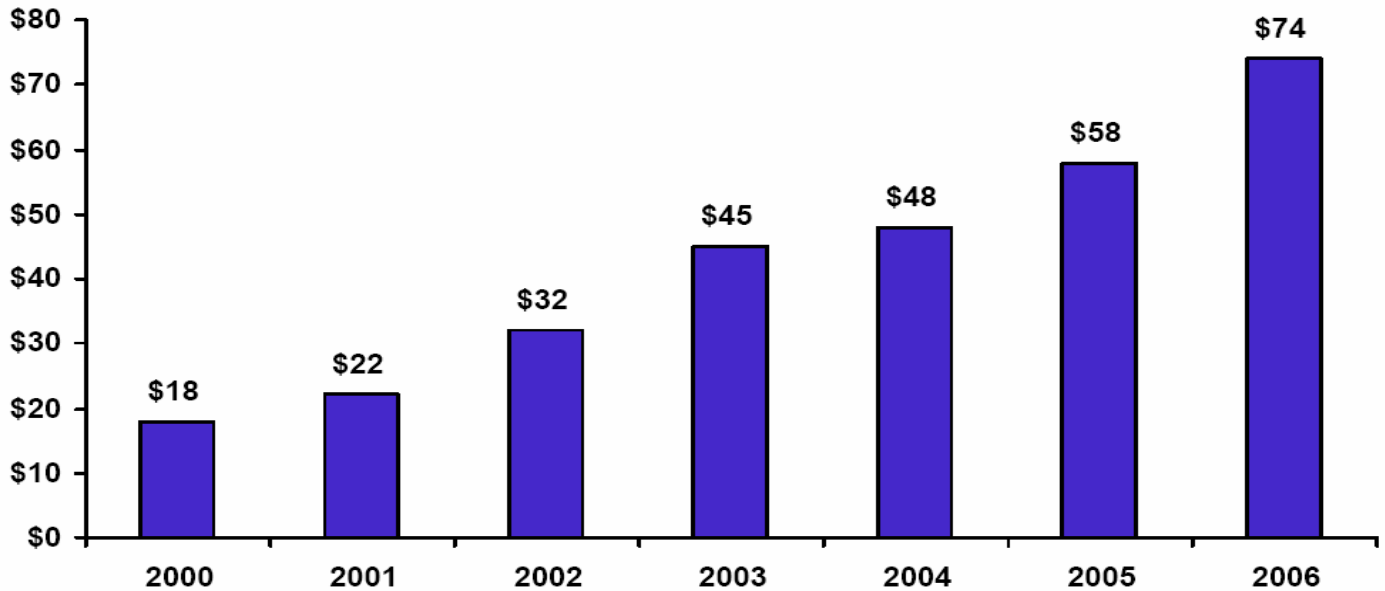

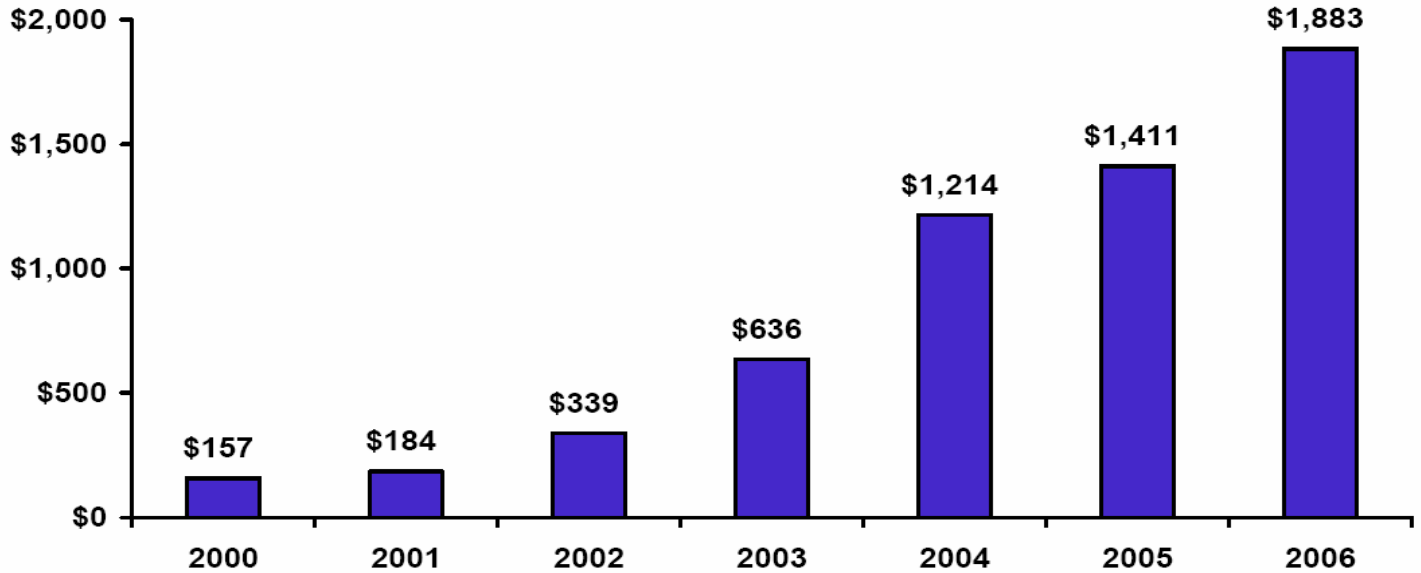

Tennessee Exports to China (\$ million)

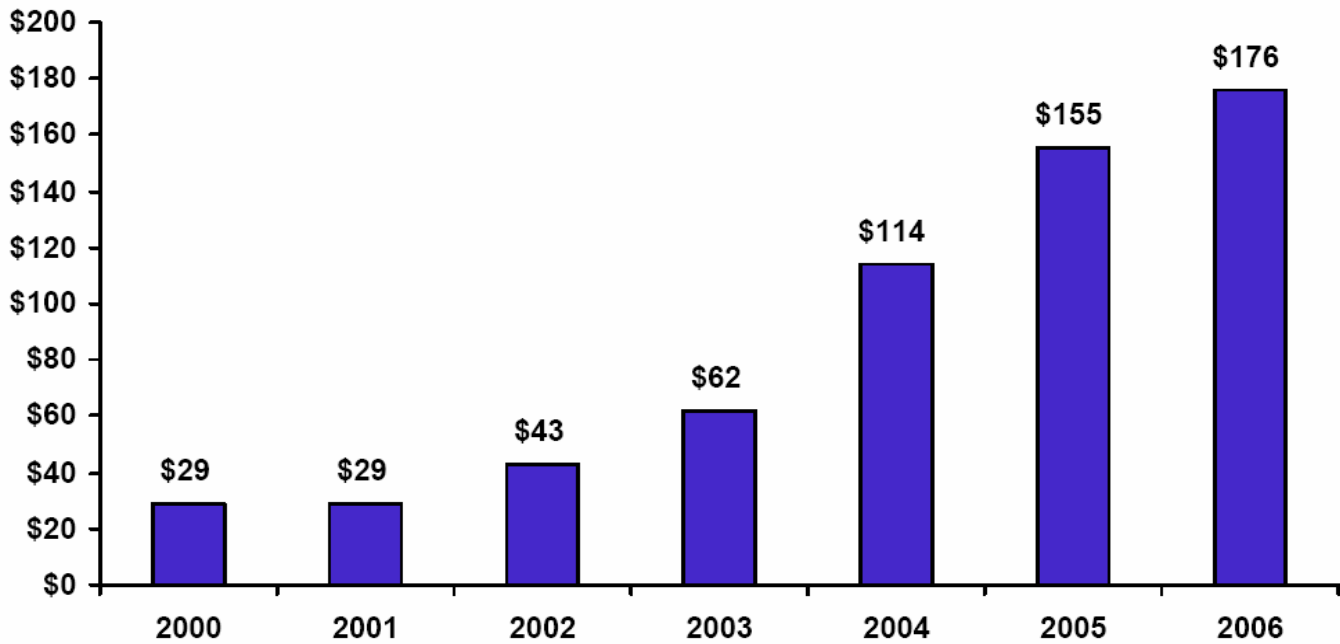
