

6. APPLICATION DEADLINE AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

- **By February 5th, 2010**, the following application documents and payments must be submitted: (\$100 discount if application received **by January 26th, 2010**)
 1. Your completed Application Form
 2. Your signed Health Information Form
 3. Your signed Assumption of Risk and Condition of Participation Form
 4. Copy of the picture page of your passport
 5. A non-refundable check of \$200 application fee and a check of \$1,000 first payment (or \$900 with discount) payable to: Marshall University Research Corporation
- **By February 16th, 2010**. the remaining \$1,000 program fee is due (\$800 for a spouse or friend applying also to share the hotel room)
- **By March 5th, 2010**, the following payment and documents must be submitted:
 1. Your actual passport*
 2. Two passport size photos for visa application form (with your name on the back of the photos)
 3. Completed and signed visa application form
 4. Payment for flight to China**

*We will need to send your passport to the Chinese Embassy to get your visa to China. Your passport with visa will be returned to you in about two weeks.

**We will book your flights to China on a US airline carrier in March when promotional fare to China becomes available. Please write your check or money order to pay to: China International Travel Service. Credit card payment is also acceptable for flight purchase. Actual price for the flights will be available at the time of booking. Unless you indicate special flight arrangement, all participants from SW Virginia will depart from and return to Knoxville, TN. All West Virginia participants will depart from and return to Charleston, WV.
